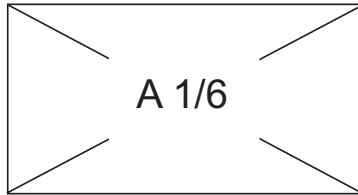
MARKING OF POULTRY MEAT

Buy only poultry meat with official markings

Poultry meat from approved abattoirs where official meat inspection is carried out by qualified poultry meat examiners and inspectors is marked as follows:



Poultry meat from approved abattoirs with the exemption of official meat inspection is marked as follows:



These markings are the same as for red meat inspection. In the case of poultry the markings are on the wrapping of the meat.
